CLOSING HYMN is "Go, My Children, With My Blessing" (LSB 922) by Jaroslav Vajda (1919-2008). Born of Czechoslovakian parents, Vajda attended Concordia College in Fort Wayne and Concordia Seminary in St. Louis. He served several LCMS congregations and also worked as a book editor and developer for Concordia Publishing House (CPH) for many years. Vajda is well known as both a writer and translator of hymns, especially ones with Czech texts. "Go, My Children" was written for CPH as an alternative text for the Welsh tune AR HYD Y NOS, which is usually sung to "God, Who Made the Earth and Heaven" (LSB 877).
