**NEXT WEEKEND** we celebrate The Eighth Sunday after Pentecost. The sermon is titled "It All Belongs to God," and the hymn of the day is "Gracious God, You Send Great Blessings" (LSB 782). The scripture lessons for worship are:

Gospel (sermon text)	Luke 12:13-21	<i>The Parable of the Rich Fool</i>

**HYMN OF THE DAY** is "Our Father, Who from Heaven Above" (LSB 766) by Martin Luther (1483-1546). This hymn version of the Lord's Prayer is part of a series that Luther wrote on the themes of the Small Catechism: "These Are the Holy Ten Commands" (Ten Commandments LSB 581), "We All Believe in One True God" (Creed LSB 954), "O Lord, We Praise You" (Communion LSB 617), and "To Jordan Came the Christ, Our Lord" (Baptism LSB 406). Most of the stanzas of "Our Father, Who from Heaven Above" state the petitions of the Lord's Prayer, with the literal text of the prayer followed by its catechetical explanation. This hymn is known not only by its printed versions, but also by a rare manuscript in Luther's own hand.
