DISTRIBUTION HYMN is "My Faith Looks Up to Thee" (LSB 702) by Ray Palmer (1808-1887), a Congregational pastor in New England. He wrote this hymn in 1830, shortly after graduating from Yale. A few years later, Palmer met Lowell Mason (1792-1872), who was compiling a new hymnal and asked Palmer to contribute to it. Mason himself wrote the tune OLIVET for "My Faith Looks Up to Thee," which is now Palmer's most famous hymn. Mason was a leading figure in church music in the 19th-c. United States; besides teaching, composing, and writing, he helped found the Boston Academy of Music.
