**CHOIR ANTHEM** is the anonymous hymn "Be Thou My Vision," which is found in two 8<sup>th</sup>-c. manuscripts in the Royal Irish Academy Library. This text is known as a *lorica* ("breastplate armor"), which is a prayer for protection in the monastic tradition. The only melody associated with this hymn is SLANE, an old Irish tune first published in an early 20<sup>th</sup>-c. collection of folk songs. As we celebrate Trinity's anniversary this weekend, we hear the prayer: "Heart of my own heart, whatever befall, still be my Vision, O Ruler of all."
