HYMN OF THE DAY "'How Shall They Hear,' Who Have Not Heard" (LSB 831) is a fairly new missionary hymn written by Timothy Dudley-Smith (b. 1926). It was commissioned for a conference of the Consultation on World Evangelization, held in Pattaya, Thailand in June 1980. A leader among living hymn writers, Dudley-Smith has penned more than five hundred hymns which are found in collections throughout the English-speaking world. Other well-known hymns by Dudley-Smith include "No Tramp of Solders' Marching Feet" (LSB 444) and "Christ Be My Leader" (LSB 861).
