CLOSING HYMN is "Guide Me, O Thou Great Redeemer" (LSB 918), originally written in Welsh by William Williams (1717-1791). While several Welsh tunes are familiar throughout Christendom, this hymn is the only one well-known outside of Wales, because Welsh is a very different language from English and difficult to translate. The opening line in the original is "Arglwydd, arwain trwy'r anialwch." It was first published in 1762 as a pilgrimage hymn in William's collection *Caniadau y rhai sydd ar y Mor o Wydr*, which means "The songs of those upon the sea of glass." The popular tune CYM RHONDDA is named for the valley of the Rhondda river in south Wales' most prominent coal mining region. This melody was composed by John Hughes (1873-1932) for a Baptist Welsh singing festival in 1903.
