## Trinity Christian Nursery Preschool News

### March 2010

**Reflections:** February was an exciting, busy month. We had parties, visitors, pictures, singing, and playing outside. We learned about friendship and how to deal with our feelings. The children are beginning to gain more independence with trying challenges first and then asking for help. During chapel time we finished talking about the stained glass windows and what they mean. We also began working on our new music that we will be singing at Church in April. The class focused on writing/identifying letters O-R, reading numbers, and counting objects to match numbers.

**Themes:** This month we will be learning about St. Patrick's Day, Spring, letter identification, graphing, patterns, number identification, and the biblical story of Moses. The letters that we will focus on learning are S-V. Each day the kids are getting better and better at writing their names. We hope to continue the teamwork with your family in this area. They are beginning to understand the numbers and counting objects too, and we would also like for everyone to practice at home number and letter identification. By doing this, it will help reinforce what the children are working on at school. Our continued goal for all the preschoolers is for them to be able to write their names, count to 20, recognize the numbers up to 10, and recognize all of the letters of the alphabet. Pastor Rogers and Trinity's Music Kantor, Ms. Mary will begin to teach us about the other sets of stained glass windows, talk about Lent, and prepare us to sing in April.

**Registration:** By the end of the month, registration will be going out for a 2's, 3's, and 4's program. We are very excited about adding a 2's program; if you have a child or know someone that will be 2 by September 1<sup>st</sup> let Ms. Heather know.
