These activities will enhance your student's abilities and understanding of theatre, particularly in the areas of auditioning, scene work, vocal projection, and stage craft.

Information about our Production:

Based on the 1991 award winning film, *Beauty and the Beast* tells the story of a prince who is transformed into a hideous beast as punishment for his cruel and selfish ways, and an adventurous young woman named Belle who he imprisons in his castle. In order to become human again, the Beast must earn Belle's love before it's too late. The musical went on to run for 5,461 performances, becoming Broadway's eighth longest- running production in history.

Your students will participate in an adapted version of this original musical, performing specific scenes and musical numbers from the show. The final performance will be held on Saturday, July 12th and will include every student who participated in our summer camp. The performance will be held at 5:30PM and will be free to the public!

Camp Opportunities:

By enrolling in our camp, your student will have the opportunity to participate in the following theater workshops and activities:

Guest Artist Q&A- Students will have the opportunity to meet and speak with an established Chicago-based actor during their lunch break one day of camp.

Learning Audition Basics- During this workshop, students will learn proper audition etiquette including what to prepare, what to wear, how to speak with directors, and how to have the most successful audition possible.

Preparing the Body- The Actor's Guide to Warm-Ups- This workshop will provide our students with exercises they can use on their own to prepare both their bodies and their voices for an upcoming performance.

Lunch Break:

All students will be given a half hour lunch break each day of camp. Students are to bring a sack lunch with them each day. They are not to leave the building during the lunch break.

Drop Off/Pick Up:

Camp will begin promptly at 9 AM. Trinity Lutheran Church is located at **300 S. Ardmore Ave Villa Park, IL 60181**. Students are to enter through the School rd. entrance and will be met by the Trinity Music Center staff each morning. Parents will need to pick up their students at this same entrance at 2PM each day. For safety purposes parents must enter the building to pick up their students.
