DISTRIBUTION HYMN is "Today Your Mercy Calls Us" (LSB 915) by Oswald Allen (1816-1878). Allen was born in Westmoreland, England into a banking family and followed this line of work throughout his life. In 1862, he published 148 of his hymns, many written during the severe winter of 1859-1860. This winter season included a storm that sank a fully-rigged sailing ship with 500 people (and gold bullion) on board. Similar shipwrecks (more than 200 that winter) led to the establishment of "gale warning" signals on the British and Irish coastlines. The tune ANTHES is named after the German pastor Frederich K. Anthes (1812-1874), who wrote the melody.

DURING THE EDUCATION HOUR, Pastor will be teaching a class reviewing the teachings of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod.
