**DISTRIBUTION HYMN** is "Jesus, Grant that Balm and Healing" (LSB 421) by the pastor Johann Heerman (1585-1647). During the Thirty Years' War, he served a German church in Koben (today in Poland). Several times he lost all his possessions and had to flee for his life. The tune DER AM KREUZ was composed by Johann Balthasar König (1691-1758), who worked in Frankfurt both as a church and civic music director. König's hymnal *Harmonischer Liederschatz* (1738) contains 1,913 of his hymn tunes.
