Gospel (sermon text) Luke 1:26-38 Birth of Jesus Foretold

CLOSING HYMN is "Prepare the Royal Highway" (LSB 343) by the pastor and bishop Frans Michael Franzén (1772-1847). Franzén was educated in Turku, Finland, at the Swedish-language University of Abo, where he became Librarian and Professor of Literary History. He then served in several ecclesiastical positions in Sweden, concluding as bishop of Hernosand (north of Stockholm on the Gulf of Bothnia). "Prepare the Royal Highway" is almost always sung to the dance-like Swedish tune BEREDEN VÄG FÖR HERRAN, first published in the late 17th century.
