NEXT WEEKEND we celebrate The First Sunday after Christmas. The sermon is titled "Go in Peace," and the hymn of the day is "O Lord, Now Let Your Servant" (LSB 211). The scripture lessons for worship are:

Old Testament Isaiah 61:10—62:3 Zion's Coming Salvation

Epistle Galatians 4:4–7 Sons and Heirs

Gospel (sermon text) Luke 2:22-40 Jesus Presented at the Temple

ADVENT HYMN (Sat, Dec 23) The verses of "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" are based on seven antiphons, one for each day between December 17 and 23. The "O" antiphons (signifying a direct address to Christ) are performed before and after the Magnificat in the Vespers services on these seven days. The final antiphon for December 23—Emmanuel—is the most famous and also the most specific, as it refers to Christ as a human child (Isaiah 7:14).
