**HYMN OF THE DAY** "Jesus on the Mountain Peak" is LSB 415, written by the British hymn writer Brian Wren (b. 1936). Late in the last century, when the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod was preparing *Hymnal Supplement 98*, a contest was announced for a new musical setting of "Jesus on the Mountain Peak." The winner was Theodore Beck (1929-2003), professor of music at Concordia University Nebraska from 1953-2001. Beck, who retired in 1997, named his tune SEWARD after the location of the university where he taught for almost fifty years. Jonathan Stahlke also entered the contest, and today at Trinity we are singing the melody he composed for Wren's lyrics.
