**ENTRANCE AND CLOSING HYMN** is "Hail to the Lord's Anointed" (LSB 398), a paraphrase of Psalm 72 written by the Scottish-born poet James Montgomery (1771-1854). At age six, Montgomery was sent to a Moravian seminary in Leeds, England. A few years later, his parents moved to the West Indies as Moravian missionaries, but they both died while overseas. Montgomery did not do well academically at the seminary and was eventually released due to poor performance. He worked mostly in Sheffield at a variety of jobs, including baker, chandler (candle maker), storekeeper, and newspaper editor. On the side, he wrote a great deal of poetry and over 400 hymns, including "Angels from the Realms of Glory" (LSB 367) and "Go to Dark Gethsemane" (LSB 436). His Moravian training can be seen in the humanitarian themes of his hymns (e.g., the abolition of slavery, the evils of the lottery, and the exploitation of child chimney sweeps).
