NEXT WEEKEND we celebrate The Resurrection of Our Lord. The sermon is titled "Resurrection Window," and the hymn of the day is "Jesus Christ is Risen Today" (LSB 457). The scripture lessons for worship are:

PALM SUNDAY, described in all four Gospel accounts, always takes place one week before Easter, as recorded in the Gospel of John. Processionals on Palm Sunday date back to the 4th century, as recorded in the travelogue *Peregrinatio Etheriae* (Pilgrimage of Etheria), which describes Christian pilgrims walking into Jerusalem to reenact Christ's entry into the city. The hymn "All Glory, Laud, and Honor" (LSB 442) was added to the celebration in the 9th century. In some Christian traditions, the palms used in the processional are taken home by worshippers and placed in Bibles as bookmarks or mounted as wall decorations for the coming year.
