**HYMN OF THE DAY** is "O Blessed Spring" (LSB 595) by the American poet Susan Palo Cherwien (1953-1921). This text, which traces the stages of life, will be sung today by singers of different ages. Cherwien was inspired by the sculpture "LIFE-TREE" created by Paul Granlund (1925-2003), who was the artist-in-residence at Gustavus Adolphus College in St. Peter, Minnesota. Cherwien writes: "This hymn was shaped by the seasons of life portrayed in the sculpture and ... is based on the scripture verse Granlund chose: 'I am the vine, you are the branches.'" (John 15:5a). The tune O WALY WALY is an anonymous English folk melody, probably originating in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. It is also well-known in the Appalachian region of the United States.
