At Wittenberg University, Selneccer became a favorite student of Melanchthon, graduated with a degree in theology, and then taught there as a "privat-docent" to as many as 200 students. During his career, Selneccer served as pastor in many prominent German churches and courts, wrote numerous books and hymns, and continued to teach as a university professor. With two other theologians, Selneccer is an author of the *Formula of Concord*.
