GLORIA is a hymn setting of the liturgical text: "Glory to God, We Give You Thanks and Praise" (LSB 946), likely written after 1984 by the Anglican pastor Edwin Le Grice (1911-1992). The text appeared as the Gloria in the LCMS *Hymnal Supplement 1998;* it was originally intended as the Gloria for Divine Service IV in LSB. Due to copyright issues, permission was delayed, and in the meantime, a different Gloria was commissioned and accepted. The tune WOODLANDS was composed by Walter Greatorex (1877-1949) and is named after one of the houses at Gresham's School in Holt (Norfolk) where Greatorex served as music director.
