**NEXT WEEKEND** we celebrate The Seventeenth Sunday after Pentecost. The sermon is titled "Bring on the Suffering!" and the hymn of the day is "Salvation Unto Us Has Come" (LSB 555). The scripture lessons for worship are:

**HYMN OF THE DAY** is "Come Down, O Love Divine" (LSB 501) by Bianco da Siena (c. 1350-1434), an Italian poet and wool worker. In 1367 he entered the Order of Jesuates, which included unordained men following the rule of St. Augustine. Bianco's well-known Pentecost hymn was translated into English by Richard Littledale (1833-90), and the tune was composed by the renowned English composer Ralph Vaughan Williams (1872-1958). Vaughan Williams named the tune DOWN AMPNEY after the village in which he was born and baptized, & where his father served as vicar. Down Ampney (pronounced *Amney*) is a village in the Cotswolds, 100 miles west of London, with a population of about 700 people.
