NEXT WEEKEND we celebrate The Twenty-Fifth Sunday after Pentecost. The sermon is titled "Measured Twice and Cut Once," and the hymn of the day is "Lord of All Hopefulness" (LSB 738). The scripture lessons for worship are:

Old Testament	1 Kings 17:8-16	<i>The Widow of Zarephath</i>
Epistle (sermon text)	Hebrews 9:24-28	<i>Redemption Through the Blood of Christ</i>
Gospel	Mark 12:38-44	<i>Beware of the Scribes</i>

HYMN OF THE DAY is "For All the Saints" (LSB 677) by the English Anglican bishop William Walsham How (1823-1897). The tune SINE NOMINE was composed by the famous English composer Ralph Vaughan Williams (1872-1958). It is thought that Vaughan Williams named the tune "Sine Nomine" (literally, without name) because on the Festival of All Saints we celebrate the Christians who have gone before us, even if their names are known only to God.
