**HYMN OF THE DAY** is "Thy Strong Word" (LSB 578) by Martin Franzmann (1907-1976), a Lutheran pastor, teacher, and hymn writer. Besides education and theological training in Wisconsin, Franzmann studied classics at the University of Chicago for over twenty years. He was professor of New Testament at Northwestern College (Watertown, Wisconsin) and at Concordia Seminary in St. Louis. In 1969, Franzmann was ordained and moved to England as a tutor at Westfield House in Cambridge, which is the seminary of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of England.
