**HYMN OF THE DAY** is "When Israel was in Egypt Land," an African-American spiritual that predates the Civil War. In 1872, it appeared in the *Jubilee Songs* and was often sung on concert tours by the Jubilee Singers of Fisk University in Nashville. The tune name GO DOWN MOSES is also considered to be another title for this hymn.
