NEXT WEEKEND we celebrate The Fifth Sunday of Easter. The sermon is titled "On Rooting Plants and Raising Chickens," and the hymn of the day is "O Blessed Spring" (LSB 595). The scripture lessons for worship are:

First Reading Acts 8:26–40 Philip and the Ethiopian Eunuch

Epistle 1 John 4:1–11 *Test the Spirits*Gospel (sermon text) John 15:1-8 *I Am the True Vine*

ENTRANCE HYMN is "He's Risen, He's Risen" (LSB 480), written in German by C. F. W. Walther (1811-1887) and translated into English by Anna Meyer (1867-1941). Walther studied theology in Leipzig, received ordination in 1837, and immigrated to the U.S. in 1839. More than any other person, Walther played a key role in the founding of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod and served as its first president. He played a key role in establishing Concordia Publishing House and Concordia Seminary in St. Louis. He also compiled *Kirchengesangbuch* (1847), the first hymnal of the LCMS. He composed the tune WALTHER, which is unusual since most hymns are set to music by a different person than the author of the text.
