HYMN OF THE DAY is "Spread the Reign of God the Lord" (LSB 830) by the German pastor Jonathan Friedrich Bahnmaier (1774-1841). The tune GOTT SEI DANK was composed by pastor Johann Anastasius Freylinghausen (1670-1739), a close colleague of the Pietist preacher August Hermann Francke. Freylinghausen became director of the influential Francke Institutions in Halle, which provided orphanage care and education according to Pietist principle
